- Pets are to be on a leash, not left unattended at any time, quiet at all times, kept out of all buildings, put in your camper at night and please clean up after them promptly.

## SITE RULES

- NO pit bikes of any kind.
- NO alcohol off your personal campsite.
- NO generators or other obtrusive noise past 11pm.
- NO PARKING roadways of access routes at any time.
- NO wristband and you will be considered to be trespassing and will be escorted from the site.
- NO vehicles anywhere on the property that does not correctly display the official vehicle pass. They will be removed at owner's expense.
- NO riding bike in the pit area riders may walk beside bike with bike running.
- NO under age drink on site
- NO disposal of contaminating waste on site
